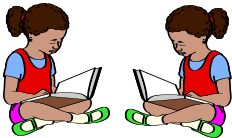

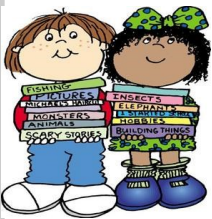

## TK/Kindergarten Readiness

Ages: 4 1/2, able to enter TK/Kindergarten program in the fall and **potty-trained/now**

The St. Clare TK/Kindergarten Readiness Program is designed specifically to meet the needs of children transitioning from preschool to TK/Kindergarten. ## Bead Ceremony & Campfire

Our Day Camp is based on seven program objectives that will be achieved by every camper. These objectives relate both to self and to interactions with others and with the environment. CKZ programs seek to help campers do the following: Grow Personally \*Develop Specific Skills \*Responsibility \*Improve Personal and Family Relationships \*Appreciate Diversity \*Become a Better Leader and Supporter \*Have Fun. Throughout the summer, these objectives are discussed and reinforced with the children in and out of camp through arts and crafts, science, dramatic play, group games, storytelling, and many other ways. During this process, our campers are encouraged to succeed and become the best people that they can be.

Every Monday, each child who is enrolled is given a necklace. This necklace represents the *never-ending spirit* of Cool Kids Zone. As the summer goes on, each camper has the opportunity to earn beads of multiple colors, each color illustrating an objective. As leaders and other campers observe these goals being demonstrated, the camper is given the beads at a special "bead ceremony" which is held every Friday.

## L.I.T Program (Leadership Development) Entering grades 7th - 8th grades

Dates: June 10— July 26 (training in the a.m. and leading in the p.m.)

Fee: \$275.00 per week (\*CPR/First Aid Certification only WK 1 & 4 training/materials/admission fees/snacks)



Be a future Cool Kids Zone Camp Leader! Have fun! Learn skills that will help you become a leader in your school and community. Learn how to work together as a team, learn outdoor living skills, team building, building positive self esteem. Participants will be selected and they will have to write a paper as to why they want to be a LIT leader and what they will do to make a difference in a campers life. This paper must be type written and turned in to the Director before camp starts. Lit's must sign-up for a minimum of 3 weeks of camp. Only the serious should apply.

## Daily Sports 4:00p—4:50p

This is just right for the child that enjoys sports. Each sport session is one week for 50 minutes per day. Your camper will develop their skills of dribbling, passing, shooting, hitting, catching, and scoring. Campers will learn the basic concept of offense and defense and the rules of each sport beginning with Baseball, Soccer, Basketball and Football. These sports skills are included with the Camp fee.
