Program Description

Be a future Cool Kids Zone Camp Leader. Have fun! L.I.T's will meet weekly with the camp leader for feedback. They will receive a handbook that describes camp rules, dress code, activities, etc. L.I.T's are required to bring the hand book every day. L.I.T's will go through CPR/First Aid training and certification. They will learn important skills including team building and building self-esteem. LIT's will be learning leadership skills while enjoying the summer!

Requirements to Enter Program

Students must want to work with children and others. Students must submit a one page paper stating why they want to join the L.I.T. program, how they might influence the campers and any experience interacting with children (babysitting, sports, team work, school activities, etc.).
